About: The High Line Open Studios provides a rare opportunity for the community and tourists to meet our local contemporary artists who keep this historic art neighborhood vibrant. The artists will be on-hand to show their most recent artworks and discuss their artistic practice. Artworks will be available in a wide range of media including — but not limited to— painting, sculpture, photography, mixed-media, textiles, prints, collage, street art, and much more!

The two-day event attracts art enthusiasts, collectors, curators, artists, and tourists to the neighborhood making it a community-wide celebration. While typically only accessible by appointment, visitors will be granted access "behind the scenes" to explore each artist's creative space. The intimate setting gives art buyers and collectors the rare opportunity to purchase artworks directly from the artists' inventory without the gallery markup. It's also a fantastic way to discover new emerging talent while their work is still affordable.

The High Line Open Studios is organized and presented by West Chelsea artist, Scotto Mycklebust, artist/executive producer, and the Public Art Squad Project.
