Public Art Performance • *Roll The Ball* by Ujin Lee

October 16, 12 - 3 p.m.

Artist Ujin Lee presents public art project "Roll the Ball" on October 16 with High Line Open Studios Chelsea 2011 (sponsored by AT&T). Roll the ball is a site specific public art project consisting of a performance, an installation, and public participation. Artist Ujin Lee will carry out the performance by appearing with a three foot tall ball made by winding more than 1000 traditional Korean wrapping cloths, or bojagi; each measuring 33x33 inches and folded and tied end to end. Lee will roll the ball to unwind the rope of tied cloths lying flat on the ground. She will then roll the rope back into a large ball. When the ball is complete, she will exit the site and the ball will remain on display for an hour of installation viewing. The public will then be invited to again roll and unravel the ball and untie the individual cloths to take home. The project will end when all the cloths have been carried away and the space is once again empty. The entire process will be video documented.

Public participation will start at 3 p.m. and end when the whole ball of cloths has disappeared.
